

## Teen Advisors of Norman

- The Teen Advisors of Norman, (TAN), is a group of teenagers, organized by teenagers, whose goal is to help other kids and families in the community, and bring about a positive image of teens.
- TAN is an initiative/youth program of the United Way of Norman
- TAN participation will involve fundraising, volunteer work, monthly meetings and a commitment to the cause.
- TAN members include incoming sophomores, juniors and seniors from Norman High and Norman North.
- TAN is a very student driven group. The kids decide what projects, volunteering, fundraisers ect. that they want to do, with direction from the adult advisors
